## The earlier the better

Patient deterioration threatens lives and outcomes while adding to the cost burden for healthcare providers. With the Clinical Surveillance solution from Ascom, patient deterioration can be detected early to help clinicians intervene and minimize the impact on patients, workloads and budgets.



#### Putting lives at risk and strain on budgets

Up to 40% of unanticipated deaths in hospitals occur in the general wards¹, while one in every six patients in medical/ surgical units develops a complication during their stay². The resulting severe adverse events, ICU bounce-backs and increased length of stay don't just put patient lives and outcomes at risk. They also directly increase the cost of care, with an estimated 15% of hospital spending attributable to addressing adverse events³.


The earlier patient deterioration is detected the better for all. However, the early signs are hard for clinicians to detect when they are managing multiple patients and lack the clinical context of the patient deterioration.

#### **Clinical Surveillance solution**

Supporting the clinicians' decision-making solution with an integrated, score-based clinical surveillance tool, patients can be continuously monitored – in general wards, emergency departments or even at home using wearables. When there are signs of deterioration, clinicians are alerted as early as possible.


## How the Clinical Surveillance solution works - detecting patient deterioration on the general ward



## **Key features**
